An interview discussing the life of a writer; the importance of writing personally and professionally; James's background, as well as influences on his work, (illustrated with material from authors and others who are, or have been, important to him); how and why he became a writer; the challenges and rewards of being one, as well as of teaching; and reflecting on life and living in Norfolk. James's published plays include *Time and Tide* (Park Theatre; Offie nominated for Best New Play 2020) and *Rubber Ring* (Pleasance Islington/UK Tour). His poetry books include *Wild Life* (Nine Arches Press), *Erased* (Polari Press) and *Manatomy* (Burning Eye; longlisted for Polari's First Book Prize 2021). He is also one of the writers on BBC soap opera *EastEnders* and has written plays for BBC Radio 4. He is an Arvon writing tutor and teaches scriptwriting at the University of East Anglia.
