This screening of *II Postino* is planned to gauge peoples' interest in a World Cinema Club (WCC) at the Community Centre.

Philippe Noiret, who starred as the projectionist in *Cinema Paradiso*, plays Pablo Neruda, a famous Chilean poet, who has been exiled to a small Italian island for political reasons. On the island, the unemployed son of a poor fisherman is hired as an extra postman due to the huge increase in mail that this causes. Il Postino is to hand-deliver the celebrity's mail to him. Though poorly educated, the postman learns to love poetry and eventually befriends Neruda. Struggling to grow and express himself more fully, he suddenly falls in love and needs Neruda's help and guidance more than ever...

If this screening is successful, and it looks like there is a demand for a WCC, then it is proposed to start in September with the following dates for screenings on the last Wednesday of each month. Please note there will no screenings in December, nor in February when the annual Film Festival happens.

The full programme of six films will be announced at this screeing if the WCC is going ahead. It is hoped people will buy a season ticket to see all six films as this will help to secure the future of WCC and enable us to proceed with confidence that all the costs involved will be covered.
